Prof. Dal Molin is working in WP 10, which will analyse the main national health and support laws, strategies and plans to identify the main issues targeted to older individuals, including those focused on promotion of healthy ageing.</p> <p><u>AGING Project - Department of Excellence</u> - The primary objective of the AGING Project is to consolidate and advance the Department's standing in the field of Aging Sciences. The project seamlessly integrates three key activities: i) Basic and Translational Research on Aging (TRANSLAGING); ii) Organizational-Models and Development of Welfare Systems (BETTERCARE4AGING); iii) Teaching Aging (TEACHINGAGING). Professor Dal Molin is leader of BETTERCARE4AGING area, which aims to implement organizational models capable of developing innovative strategies to improve care for the elderly.</p> <p><u>BeEmTel Project</u> (Beyond the Emergency. Telecare for Non-Communicable Diseases through Simulation Techniques) - aims to provide innovative training accessible to students from various disciplines whose focus is telemedicine in the management of chronic diseases (Nov. 2021 - Nov. 2024).
